Dr. Richard Wilson earned his Masters in Nurse Anesthesia from the University of South Carolina School of Medicine (2006) and his Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice from the Medical University of South Carolina (2022). He currently serves as Assistant Program Director – East Coast for Ursuline

College's Somnia Nurse Anesthesia Program and previously helped open the University of South Carolina's second campus in Greenville, SC. He authored the Blood Component Therapy chapter in the latest edition of Nurse Anesthesia and has published in JOPAN and the AANA Journal. In 2023, he was selected as a Fellow of the American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology, serves as an AANA Social Media Ambassador, was elected to the AANA Leadership Identification

Committee, and continues to practice clinically while mentoring future CRNAs through CRNA School Prep Academy.
